Dual purpose hop. Very balanced hop, sometimes called a super Cascade. Good in all US Ale styles, has been used with US Wheat beers.





## **ORIGIN / HISTORY**

US origin. Selected from a cross between Brewer's Gold and a selected USDA male.

#### **AGRONOMICS**

Good, neat well hopped bines maturing mid-season. A medium sized dense compact cone. No visible reaction to infection with Prunus necrotic ring-spot virus. Moderately resistant to Verticillium Wilt.

#### **ACID COMPONENTS**

Alpha Acids 7 – 12% w/w Beta Acids 3.5 - 5% w/w

Cohumulone 29 – 30% of alpha acids

Myrcene
