## HALLERTAU TAURUS

### BREWING QUALITY

Hallertau Taurus is a Huell bred high alpha variety with a very high alpha content and noble, aromatic bitter quality. The bitterness character is crisp, which makes it well suited to bittering of German-style lagers.



### ORIGIN / HISTORY

German origin. A late maturing hop variety that was released in 1995 by the Hop Research Institute in Hüll.

### AGRONOMICS

Fairly resistant to wilt and downy mildew, but it has a low resistance to powdery mildew.

### ACID COMPONENTS

Alpha Acids	12 – 17% w/w
Beta Acids	4 - 6% w/w
Cohumulone	20 - 25% of alpha acids

### OIL COMPONENTS

Total Oil	0.9 – 1.5 mls/100 grams
Caryophyllene	30 - 31% of whole oil
Farnesene	<1% of whole oil
Myrcene	30 - 50% of whole oil
