BREWING QUALITY

Known as a bittering hop with good aroma characteristics. Very good in American Ales.



ORIGIN / HISTORY

US origin. Simcoe® is a bittering/aroma type cultivar bred by Yakima Chief Ranches.

AGRONOMICS

Moderate tolerance to powdery mildew, Podosphaera.

ACID COMPONENTS

Alpha Acids	11 – 15% w/w
Beta Acids	4 – 5% w/w
Cohumulone	15 - 20% of alpha acids

OIL COMPONENTS

Total Oil	2 – 2.5 mls/100 grams
Caryophyllene	5 - 8% of whole oil
Farnesene	<1% of whole oil
Humulene	10 - 15% of whole oil
Myrcene	60 - 65% of total oil
